# Ancestry of George Wythe, LL. D.

George Wythe was descended from an honorable line of ancestors who had held for generations high position in the County of Elizabeth City. The following represents his descent from the immigrant, Thomas Wythe, gent.

3. Thomas<sup>2</sup> = Anne, dau. John Sheppard, (sister of Baldwin Sheppard, J. P. of E. C., will pr. 7ber, 1697.) = Quintilian Gutherick, 1<sup>st</sup> husband; administration granted in 1690, J. P. of E. C. Co.  
 (2<sup>nd</sup> husband) Will pr. 18 Sept., 1694, J. P. of E. C. Co.

Thomas<sup>3</sup> who m., in 1719-20, Margaret, dau. of George Walker, who m. a daughter of George Keith, a quaker of good fortune who wrote a folio upon mathematical and other subjects. (Story's "Diary;" Call's Reports, IV, p. 11.
